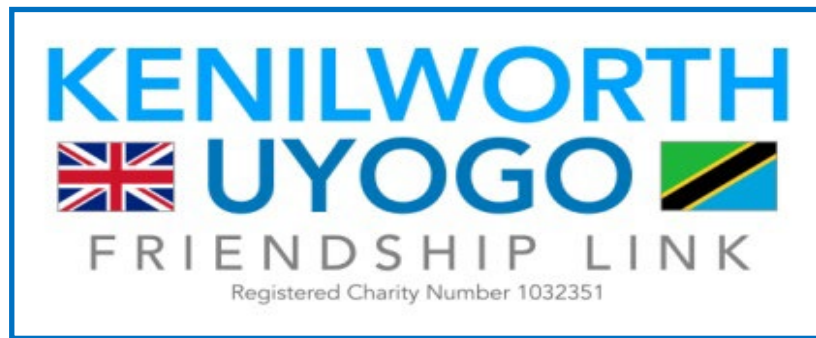




Our friendship link with Uyogo, a village in rural Africa, goes right back to 1979, the UN's Year of the Child. Kenilworth Town Council committed to making lasting changes for the better in children's lives and the link with Uyogo was created to work together to understand more about each other's lives and situation.

The link works well on many levels. For example, Kenilworth School raises funds through their annual Africa Week. This and other events throughout the year give students the opportunity to use their organisational, artistic and performance skills, while developing a deeper understanding of how global issues can affect us all.

Current projects

Protection of health, relief of poverty and advancement of education are the aims of KUFL's support to Uyogo.

The priority project for 2023 is to restore and improve the piped water supply, lost completely due to recent power fluctuations. Introducing solar power and using an alternative water source will help to prevent ill-health and protect the community from climate change. We are also completing a primary school classroom built mainly by the villagers of Igembensabo, a sub-village of Uyogo.
