**Cycling Delivery Group Report – 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022**

**Public Events**

The group hasn't met since the last Town Council but has been busy.

In December a number of the group took part in supporting the Christmas market in Talisman Square. We were joined by two of our local young people who have been running a petition in support of safe cycle routes to the new school and were able to help them gather another 300 signatures.

We also carried out a survey asking residents about their travel habits when they were at school. Around 70 took part and (unsurprisingly) the majority used to travel to school on foot or on bike.

It was also a good opportunity to engage with residents about issues regarding active travel and plans across the town. Being positioned in Talisman Square certainly helped create more opportunities for conversations.

**Infrastructure**

The design for the Clarkes Ave bridge has been reviewed by the safety team at WCC and no issues have been identified. We have requested confirmation of costs so that a business case can be submitted for CIL funding.

We are also in the process of arranging a day with the cycling team from WCC to review the priorities identified through the LCWIP. This will include visiting potential sites across the town to assess initial feasibility. We will include members of the group in this exercise to gain greater insight to the options.

**Next Steps**

At our next meeting we will begin to consider options for activity in May focussed around the supporting adult and family cycling opportunities.
