

KTC Council 6-4-23 - Climate Roadmap Group report

The last meeting was held on Tuesday 28th January 2023 7pm.

Planning for the Naturewatch week Friday 26th May-Sunday 4th June continues with Cllr Cooke contacting various groups who organised events last year. There are also opportunities for related events such as litter picking/Plastic Free Kenilworth, Kenilworth self-directed Trails, Mayor photography competition etc. It is possible that Dave Barber from WDC will promote the new Biodiversity Action Plan.

Group discussed possibility of a market on Saturday 27th May. KTC Gazebo could be used in Abbey End or Talisman Square. Cllr Coker had agreed to open talks with Talisman Square owners and CJs to see if available/possible

Spring Newsletter #9 with various items on heat pump prices, carbon literacy courses, Naturewatch 2023, new thermal imagery cameras is close to publication.

Roadmap committee member Kathryn Parsons (Kenilworth School) has met with other schools to unite activities over climate with projects on same topic area (e.g. Trash Mob events). Group was pleased to hear that the new Kenilworth School has won an Eco award. There was an event on March 17th to support Plastic-Free Kenilworth.

Since the meeting, it was agreed that KTC would purchase two thermal imagery cameras for residents' use to assess building heat losses.
