Sync Education have been running a mens wellness group called "The ARt of Brotherehood" since March 2020 with great success. We have a core group of 4 members who have trained to support other men in our community on a voluntary basis in groups and one to one.

We are making a short documentary and a short webseries of mens work in the area and how it impacts men to be part of a group. We will document stories of mens wellness journey and how our approach works. We have prevented 2 suicides in the past 2 years and we want to be able to share the impact of our work and bring it to Kenilworth.

We will host 20 mens focused talking circles and aim to connect with at least 6 male participants (from Kenilworth) during these sessions. (over 40 week period)

We will deliver 2 tried and tested wellness focused workshops to 20 Kenilworth Residents (aiming at Kenilworth small business owners) to promote the importance of self care when it comes to our holistic wellbeing.

We will create a short documentary and a small series of web episodes that highlights the Importance of mens wellness work and the challenges we face. Aiming to involve as many Kenilworth Residents as possible. (this is why we need the camera, and post project we aim to continue making short webseries celebrating community members)

We have had great feedback from the work we have already achieved and access to this pot will help to spread our message of support through video and in action through our support groups.

Men make up over 90% of the prison population. Men are the biggest percentage of both victims and perpetrators of violent crime in the UK. The new estimate for male completed suicides is now 13 a day in the UK alone (that is completed - I dread to think how many attempts daily).

Access to your fund will help to cover some of the equipment we need, editing time and the facilitation costs for wellness work over the year - We already have the resources for project and a hire space. we aim to start this project in March 2023 and finish by March 2024.
