OTHER INFORMATION IN SUPPORT OF THE APPLICATION	
I am writing on behalf of the eight scouts, two leaders and three members of the International Support Team from Kenilworth District who have been selected to attend	

the 26th World Scout Jamboree in summer 2027. We will be part of 40,000 Scouts from over the World between the ages of 14 and 17 taking part at the event in Gdansk, Poland. The World Scout Jamboree takes place every four years in different countries, and we are very proud to be representing the young people of the UK in 2027. We were selected following a competitive process and are very fortunate to be representing Kenilworth and Warwickshire at the event.

Attending the World Scout Jamboree in Poland is a once in a lifetime experience. During the Jamboree we will have the opportunity to try new skills, meet new people, grow as a person and develop life skills, understanding and resilience. It is not just about the trip, but the planning and fundraising beforehand, bringing back new skills and ideas, being motivators and mentors afterwards. Previous Jamboree participants have shared how this opportunity helped them grow in individual confidence, they made new friends and made them more confident and articulate in working with others.

The cost of attending the World Scout Jamboree is £3,100 for each person, and this cost must be met individually by the scouts, leaders and IST volunteers attending the event. This fee covers our travel costs, activities and accommodation and subsidises the cost for those Scouts attending from less wealthy countries.

We have already started a programme of fundraising to raise the total required, and have been working together to organise bake sales, car washes, quiz nights and helping out at events across the town (eg handing out water at the 2 castles run). We have also planned stalls at the Lions Show and special CJ's markets in the town. We have also been working hard individually, being creative to raise funds through making jewellery, paper rounds and bake sales.

I'm writing to request a grant from Kenilworth Town Council to contribute to the total cost of attending the Jamboree, supporting 8 young people from across the town plus the volunteer adults who travel with us, to enable us to take part in this once in a lifetime opportunity
